VII Baltic Moreno Conference ■ Tallinn, Estonia



People are telling stories and passing them on from generation to generation in order to overcome disasters, to believe in happiness and sustainability, to remain and remember – and sometimes, to forget. Narrative is an important tool to preserve the identity of nations.

VII Baltic Moreno Conference is for stories from different countries and nations to meet in psychodrama sessions.

We are inviting advanced psychodramatists to lead workshops where people can share stories more on the social level of psychodrama. We are expecting some university students to attend every workshop and write down the content of different stories to collect and publish them later in a book.

Friday afternoon is planned for city tours in smaller groups to see Tallinn from different viewpoints – Estonian, German, Russian, Jewish, Danish, Swedish, Finnish, etc. Friday evening is for the big group meeting and sharing experiences.

Saturday and Sunday workshops are divided into three sessions:

- **The War:** Pre- and Post-World War II stories, generations, secrets, traumas, etc.
- **The Wall:** Dividing Europe in two, borders, separation, connections, power, etc.
- **After the Wall:** Independence, joining, freedom, rules, new wars, building new identities, new friends and new enemies...

The big group meeting is planned to end the event.
